

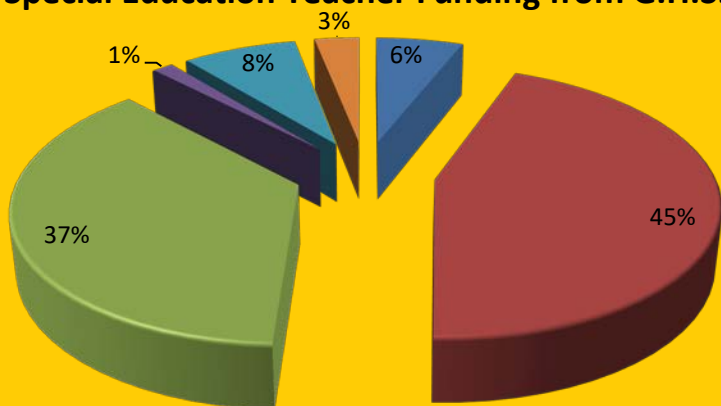


# Westmount School Budget Information 2017/18

- No extra fees to parents

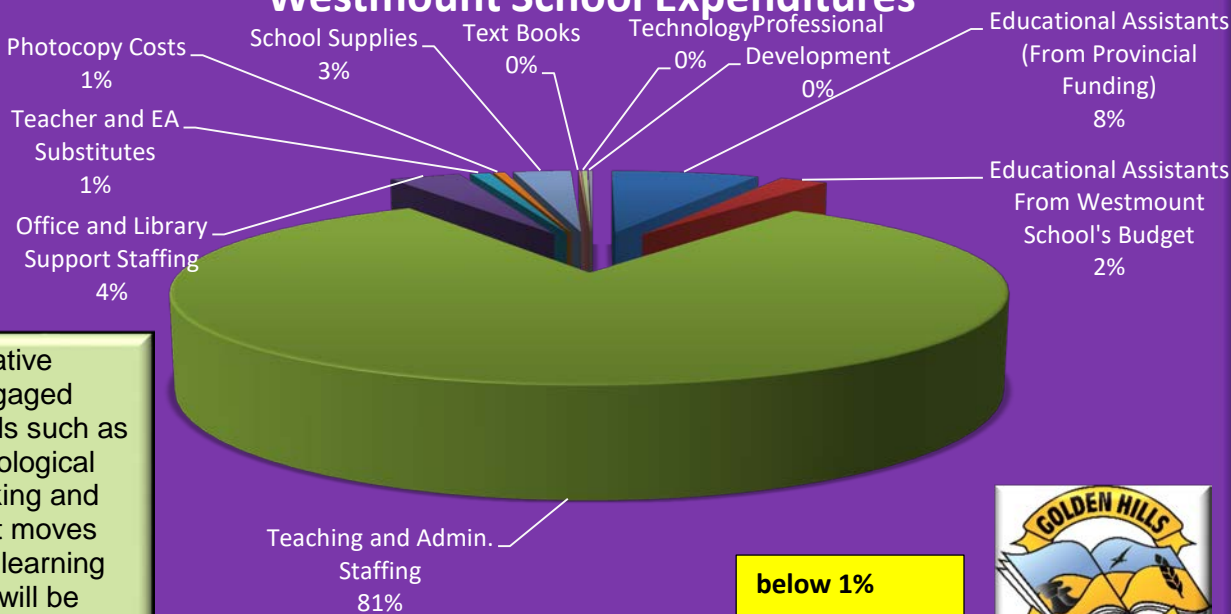
